With reference to Guidelines issued by Ministry of Higher and Technical Education (HTE) of State Government of Maharashtra related to the conduct of examinations and awarding grades, Guidelines given by UGC and AICTE related to examinations following points are clarified to the students, faculty and concerned stakeholders.

1. End Semester Examination for Final Year B.Tech (Sem-VIII) of Civil/ Mechanical / Electrical (C/M/E) Engineering, M. Tech (Sem-IV) programs of Civil/ Mechanical / Electrical Engineering will be conducted tentatively between 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020 to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2020. The examination for the backlogs of Sem-V, Sem-VI, Sem-VII for the B. Tech. Students (only for students who are now in 8<sup>th</sup> Sem) and Sem-I, Sem-II for the M. Tech. students will also be conducted in this duration. Detailed schedule of the examination will be displayed on SPCE website in due course.
2. The results of these examinations [Final Year B. Tech (Sem-VIII) and M. Tech. (Sem-IV)], will be declared tentatively by 15<sup>th</sup> Aug. 2020.
3. The detailed instructions regarding promotion / assessment (if any), award of grades and improvement examination for the students of First Year, Second Year, Third Year B. Tech and First Year M. Tech. classes will be issued on receipt of the guidelines from Dept. of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Maharashtra and /or Mumbai University and approval from the Academic Council of SPCE
4. The Institute will take all steps necessary in solving the concerns / issues of students related to examination, processing of results and award of grade. The institute will take care to maintain the sanctity of examination and safety of stakeholders in the context of Covid19.
5. The academic calendar and the instructions regarding the teaching-learning process for the academic year 2020-21, will be issued in due course of time after

the receipt of Guidelines from Mumbai University, other competent authorities and approval of the SPCE Academic Council.

6. All these instructions will be reviewed from time to time depending on lockdown and safety guidelines issued by the Govt. of Maharashtra and /or MCGM in view of the status of the COVID-19 containment in Mumbai.

All students are requested to be calm and stress free during this lockdown period and focus on their overall professional and personal development.

Students are advised to prepare for the GATE examinations. Students are suggested to complete NPTEL/Swayam courses during lockdown. AICTE has launched online courses offered by various organisations as free of charge.

Institute has received Coursera Campus membership and courses are free in pandemic due to Covid19. Students are advised to complete Courses to build their profiles. They are also advised to learn foreign language to build a competitive edge in the context of globalization of Business environment.
