Performance-Linked Hostel Fee Discount Scheme (PLHFDS)

All students aspiring to take admission to the SPCE Hostel for the Academic Year 2026–27 are hereby informed of the revised hostel fee structure and the introduction of the **Performance-Linked Hostel Fee Discount Scheme (PLHFDS)**, effective from AY 2026–27. The Scheme has been approved by the Governing Body and is designed to reward academic diligence, professional development, and responsible hostel conduct.

The revised Hostel Admission Fee structure is as follows:

Note: Mess charges are payable separately as per existing norms.

Application Process:

1. The students can earn discount in this admission fee as per their academic performance in accordance with the policy guidelines enclosed with this notice.
2. The students will need to fill Hostel Application form along with the Performance-Linked Discount Application Form (to be made available later on) and attach supporting documents: semester grade card, attendance certificate from Qviple, NPTEL/industry certification, GATE scorecard, internship completion letter, sports/cultural/research participation certificates — whichever are applicable.
3. The Hostel Fee Discount Verification Committee will evaluate applications and publish the approved discount list before the fee payment deadline.
4. Approved discounts will be directly reflected as a deduction in the hostel fee challan.

The students are advised to enhance their academic performance in order to secure maximum discount in the Hostel Admission Fees.

Policy Guidelines —
Performance-linked Hostel Fee Discount Scheme (PLHFDS)
 (Effective from Academic Year 2026–27 onwards)

Preamble

This Policy introduces a Performance-Linked Hostel Fee Discount Scheme w.e.f. AY 2026–27, concurrent with revision in the hostel fee structure. This Scheme intends to offer performance-linked discounts in the Hostel Admission fees, so that every student is incentivised for better academic performance.

I. Discount Parameters and Weightages

The following is the **point-based system** for obtaining discount in the fees.

| E3 | Corporate / Alumni / CSR Financial Support Contribution | i. Support up to ₹50,000 ii. Support above ₹50,000 and up to ₹1,00,000 iii. Support above ₹1,00,000 | 1 Point 2 Points 3 Points |

Design Rationale:


- a. Attendance (3 pts) + No Backlog (3 pts) alone = 6 pts → 7% discount.
- b. A student with merely average attendance and decent grades (attendance 3 + CGPA 7+ at 2 pts + no backlog 3 pts = 8 pts) → qualifies for 10%.
- c. Every sincere, regular student reaches the 5%–7% floor without difficulty.

III. Eligibility Criteria


- A student shall be eligible for Hostel admission and consideration under the scheme only if:
- a. The student has not been involved in any disciplinary/ragging or examination copy or malpractices case in hostel and college.
 - b. The student has not caused damage to hostel/institute/campus property.
 - c. A has minimum 75% attendance in the college in previous semester.
 - d. The allotment of hostel will be merit-based amongst the applicants.

IV. Right of the Institute


- a. This Policy shall be reviewed annually by the committee appointed for design and implementation of this policy and placed before the Governing Body for ratification.
- b. Parameters and point weightages may be revised based on institutional experience and stakeholder feedback.
- c. Any single violations of Hostel rules and Regulation all the accumulated discounts will be null and void.
- d. Regarding Final discount to offer decision of PLHIS/HOSTEL Committee will be binding to all students.
