Introduction

NIRF: The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) was approved by the Ministry of Education (MoE) and launched in September 2015. This framework outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. The methodology draws from the overall recommendations broad understanding arrived at by a Core Committee set up by MoE, to identify the broad parameters for ranking various universities and institutions.

The parameters broadly cover:

- ✚ Teaching, Learning and Resources,
- ✚ Research and Professional Practices,
- ✚ Graduation Outcomes,
- ✚ Outreach and Inclusivity and
- ✚ Perception

In recent past, NIRF ranking has become a benchmark for any reputed academic institute. For the 2020 rankings, around 3,800 institutions participated in the process, which was 20 percent more than that in 2019. This webinar will cover all the aspects of NIRF rankings and help Institute to prepare for better NIRF ranking.

NBA: The purpose of the accreditation by NBA is to promote and recognize excellence in technical education in colleges and universities-at both the UG and PG levels. Institutions, students, employers, and the public at large all benefit from the external verification of quality provided through the NBA accreditation process. They also benefit from the process of continuous quality improvement that is encouraged by the NBA's developmental approach to promote excellence in technical education. Thus NBA accreditation is a measure of quality of education imparted at any Institute and it has become a mandatory qualifying criteria for any Institute while applying for autonomy or TEQIP. This webinar will cover all the aspects of NBA accreditation and help Institute to prepare well for NBA.
