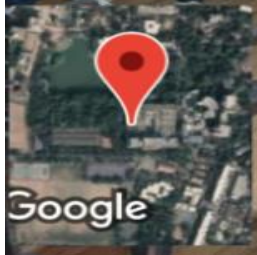
Conclusion:
