

## **ACTIVITY REPORT**

**Name of the Course : FINANCIAL LITERACY**

**Number of Sessions Conducted : 35 HOURS**



The course was successfully conducted over a period of around 4 months from August 2019 to November 2019 with 52 students from across the 3 branches clearing all the 3 practical assessments.

The initial sessions started with Basics of Economics, Accounting & Financial Planning and then went on to even cover some of the comparatively difficult topics such as Financial Instruments & Markets, Income Tax & Financial Statements. The participation & inquisitive level of students was extremely high which added a lot of value to the sessions.



The 1<sup>st</sup> Assessment of 20 marks was based on a group presentation on Financial Planning where 10 marks each were given for the group and individual respectively.



The 2<sup>nd</sup> Assessment of 20 marks was based on a group presentation on Income Tax where 10 marks each were given for the group and individual respectively.





The Final Assessment of 100 marks was based on an individual report to be submitted on a company selected by the student. The student was supposed to glance through the basic information available on public domain (Bombay Stock Exchange & National Stock Exchange websites and Balance Sheet & Profit & Loss Account from the Annual Report) about that company and present it in the form of a report & viva that was conducted for the same. The Final Assessment of 100 marks was done based on the quality of report (30 marks), performance of the student in the presentation (30 marks) and viva (40 marks).

All the students were extremely happy at the end of the Course as they are now equipped with the basic knowledge of Finance which will surely take them a long way in their professional as well as personal life & some of them have even suggested to design an advanced level Course for the same.
